14 PRIMARY ROUTES

Regularly scheduled bus routes in the City of Flint service area serving passengers throughout the day and into the evening.



YOUR RIDE SERVICES

Your Ride is personalized public transit service designed for use by persons who are unable to use fixed route bus service. Your Ride should be used only when your age or disability prevents you from using fixed route bus service or fixed route services are not available to you.

Your Ride Curb-To-Curb

For many passengers, this means that at your confirmed pickup time you should meet the Your Ride van at the curb or streetside for your pickup.

Your Ride Door-To-Door

This service enhances existing curb-to-curb service. Qualified drivers with specialized training offer assistance to senior passengers to and from vehicles, as well as to and from destination entrances. This personalized "hands on" approach will assist seniors,

60 or older, who have physical and/or mental impairments that may require an additional level of "gentle support."

Your Ride Door-Through-Door

Service provided through certification with cooperating agencies listed on back.

Designed for seniors 60 and older who have difficulty getting in and out of vehicles, buildings and, often, cannot make the trip without extra support. The MTA, working with senior groups, provides passengers with an additional level of assistance. A qualified MTA Your Ride driver with special training assists passengers inside their homes, as well as inside other buildings. Support ranges from assisting passengers with balance, climbing steps, or performing similar functions, such as helping with coats, boots, carrying packages or groceries. The MTA Your Ride driver makes certain that a passenger is ready for the ride, provides needed support to the vehicle, and escorts the passenger to an attendant or caregiver at the destination.

SENIOR SHOPPER SERVICE
